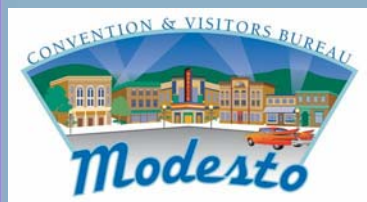
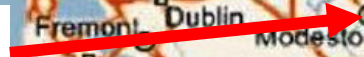

Arrival Day

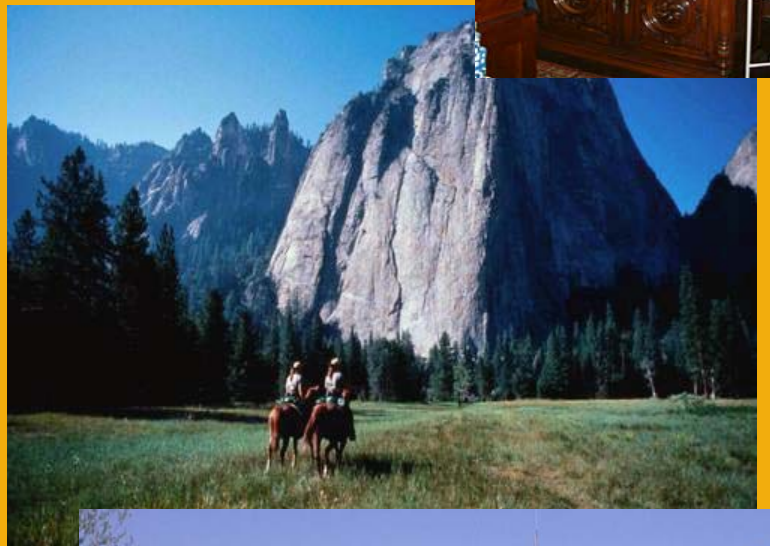
Day One – Yosemite National Park

9:45AM Return to your motor coach and continue your two hour journey to the South gate of the world famous Yosemite National Park. Day Two-Sacramento State Capital
